Four Person Scramble**

Rules and Scramble Format

1. All teams consist of four players. If a team has less than four players, each team member will alternate taking the shot of an absent player.
2. Official tees are White for Men and Red for Women.
3. All players tee off on every hole. Select the best drive to play the second shot from. Repeat until the best shot is in the cup.
4. A single score is recorded by the foursome as if only one ball is played.
5. You must use one (1) tee shot/drive from every person in the foursome during the eighteen holes. Par 3s count towards a tee shot/drive.
6. No search for any lost ball should exceed two minutes.
7. The maximum score on any hole is a bogey. Example: Hole #1 is a par 4, if team does not putt into cup or chip in on the fourth shot, then pick up the ball and record a 5 for that hole.
8. Team captains are responsible for scorecard. The scorecard must be turned in immediately following the round.
9. In case of a tie, the winner will be determined on the basis of the best score for the last nine holes. If the tying players have the same score for the last nine holes, the score for the last six holes will be used. If the score is still tied, the score for the last three holes will be used.
10. Have a great time! But, remember NO outside food or drink is allowed on the course.

Purchase a Few Helpers



Mulligans: Two for \$10.00

Each player may purchase a maximum of two mulligans (does not apply to long drive or closest to pins). Mulligans may be used anytime EXCEPT on the green and off the tee on par 3. Mulligans must be used by the purchaser and may not be shared.

Buy a Tee Shot: \$20 per Team

Buy a tee shot that lands you 200 yards from the hole! Holes #6 and #14 only. In addition to normal play, a painted circle at approximately 200 yards from the pin may be used for your teams tee shot drop. All team members play from that drop.

Team Package – a Bargain at \$60! For \$60.00 each team member is entitled to two mulligan's and the entire team receives the 200 yard from the pin shot on both hole #6 and hole #14.

Buy String: \$5.00 a foot up to 30 Feet per Team

Players will be provided the opportunity to purchase up to 30 feet of string at \$5.00 per foot. "Give me" string. The player (or team) may move his ball by hand to a more favorable spot at any time, at any place on the course (including on the putting green and into the hole), measuring with the string the distance the ball was moved and then tying a knot or cutting off the equivalent length of string. When the string is used up, the player (or team) is on his own. Any ball on the green within the length of the string will be considered as being made. **No stroke is counted.** In case of a tie, the tie breaker is the team with the longest piece of string left over.
